



JUNIOR PROGRAM 2020

“Helping Young Golfers Develop Their Games, While Maximizing Enjoyment Of The Game”

Program Options

Any youth 18 years of age or under is invited to participate in our junior program. All juniors have full playing privileges with no restrictions as to when they are able to play regardless of membership status. There are four options to choose from:

Junior Seasons Pass

Includes unlimited golf, free junior golf clinics in the spring, summer fun tournaments green fee, Junior Seasons Pass holder rate discount on driving range pass and annual city championship at the end of summer. Seasons Passes are for one individual and cannot be shared.

The cost of the junior seasons pass is \$230+tax.

Junior 20-Game 9-Hole Punch Pass

Reduces green fees to **\$9 for 9 holes**, access to summer fun tournaments, junior pass holder rate discount on driving range pass. Punch passes can be shared and carry over to the next season.

The cost of the Junior 20-Game Punch Pass is \$180+tax

Junior 10-Game 9-Hole Punch Pass

Reduces green fees to **\$10 for 9 holes**, access to summer fun tournaments, junior pass holder rate discount on driving range pass. Punch passes can be shared and carry over to the next season.

The cost of the Junior 10-Game Punch Pass is \$100+tax

Pay-As-You Go

Anyone age 18 and under will receive reduced green fees, access to summer fun tournaments and events, plus lessons with CPGA professionals are discounted for juniors. Regular cost of junior green fees is \$12.⁰⁰ for 9-holes and \$18.⁰⁰ for 18-holes.

Driving Range Seasons Pass

\$125+tax for a two-buckets-per-day pass for Junior Seasons Pass or Punch Pass holders. This provides a **savings of \$75** compared to the regular price of \$200+tax. Driving Range Seasons Passes are for one junior only and cannot be shared.

Golf Course Access

Junior golfers can book a tee time to play any day and any time, no restrictions. The only time the tee is closed is when we host events, in which case we will try to get players off the other nine. Juniors arriving as a single or with a friend, may paired up with other golfers. It is **VERY IMPORTANT** that **ALL JUNIORS BE COURTEOUS** and **OBSERVE PROPER ETIQUETTE**. Failure to do so will result in suspension of playing privileges. The greatest help can come from parents and/or adults who can play with the kids and help teach them the fundamentals of etiquette and fair play.

Junior Lesson Clinics

These lessons are 1 hour per day for 2 days and you can choose the weekend best for you. We recommend that all juniors attend these lessons. These lessons will also be available to non-members at a cost of \$25.⁰⁰. For Junior Seasons Pass holders one Spring class is included in their seasons pass cost. (2020 dates: April 25th, 26th or May 2nd, 3rd).

Meet and Greet Event

All junior golfers are welcome to join for fun contests, prizes and a light lunch. This is a great way to meet new friends and introduce kids to the game and each other. Pass holders are encouraged to bring friends and some limited tee times will be blocked off for 9 holes afterwards. Date TBD

Summer Tournaments

During the summer holidays we will run some fun tournaments for the juniors. These will run on Monday mornings starting at 10:30 am for 7 weeks (Every Monday in July & August, excluding holidays). Seasons Pass holders play for free and Punch Pass holders can use their punch card, if not a pass holder then they pay the junior green fee. The focus is on fun and there will be prizes presented after the round. All juniors 18 and under are eligible to play.

City Junior Championship

Annual age 18 and under tournament open to all juniors in the city of Vernon and surrounding area. Held at the end of Summer late August/early September. Entry fee for Hillview Seasons Pass holders is a reduced rate.

Entry Cut-off

Junior Seasons Passes are available on a first come first serve basis. Depending on the year, we can accept anywhere from 80-90 juniors into the program. After the maximum is reached names will be entered on a waitlist and receive first choice for the following year. The cut-off is usually reached in the spring but varies each year.
